The Pearson BTEC Level 1/Level 2 Tech Award in Health and Social Care is a qualification that recognises the value of learning skills, knowledge and vocational attributes linked to the Health and Social Care. This is similar to a GCSE and can lead to A-level or Level 3 qualifications.

<p>There are 3 equally weighted units. Units 1 and 2 are assessed through internal assessment.</p> <p>Unit 1 - Human Lifespan Development To understand human growth and development across life stages and the factors that affect it and investigate how individuals deal with life events.</p> <p>Unit 2 - Health and Social Care Services To understand the different types of health and social care services and barriers to accessing them and be able to demonstrate care values and review own practice</p> <p>Unit 3 - Values Health and Wellbeing. This is an external assessment. It provides the main synoptic assessment for the qualification. It builds directly on Units 1 and 2, and enables learning to be brought together and related to a real-life situation.</p>
